The Bluffton Soccer Club is off to a busy (although wet) start this spring. There are over 180 children (from 6 to 15 years old) playing on 17 Black Swamp recreational league and two travel teams. Our soccer program provides local opportunity for our youth to be involved in a healthy activity, benefit from learning teamwork, good sportsmanship and friendships outside of school. Parents, friends, and family members volunteer to coach teams, putting in many hours of involvement with our community youth.

Instead of holding a multitude of fundraiser events, hosting meals and selling stuff that we don't really need, the Bluffton Soccer Club has one big fundraiser each year: hosting the Spring Fling soccer tournament for the U12 and U15 age divisions (May 11 and 12).

This event draws teams from around northwest and west central Ohio for a busy weekend of soccer. Games are held on the campus of Bluffton University, locating families in easy proximity to downtown and nearby business locations.

We would like to invite you to participate in supporting our youth through sponsorship of the soccer tournament. Donations offset the expenses involved in hosting the tournament.
