BOARD REPORTS:

Notices for those paying half year dues have been sent out. The commitment to pledge \$15,000 by Lion members to the Bluffton Hospital project has been met. Dare to Dream goal is to raise \$30,000 this year with \$20,000 going to the pathway project. Location for the event will be held at The Centre. New member application for Shirley Wagner accepted by the board. Donation for Relay for Life of \$100 was paid.

Slate of Lion officers for the foundation was accepted as follows: President – Dick Ramseyer; Vice Pres – Judy Augsburger; Treasurer – Lowell Hostetler; Secretary – Barbara Plaugher; directors – Colleen Lazar, Ed Yeager, Greg Denecker, Dick McGarrity and Mitch Kingsley. Ride to Remember Bike Ride has both Lions & non-Lions helping with this project for the benefit of the pathway projects. A booklet is being written by Fred Steiner on the story of the Bluffton Pathway Program. The Parkview path off Kibler Street will be completed in May with dedication in June. Project cost is \$18,500. The Bentley Pathway is scheduled for 2018 with funds being split tree ways, each \$65,000 from Bluffton Lions, village and public donations.

COMMUNITY MEAL:

The Bluffton Lions provided the community meal held at the Senior Citizens building on May 4th. Lion Elaine Harris coordinated this event with the assistance of 15 Lions. 87 meals were served and a collection of over \$240 will be contributed to the Bluffton Food Bank.

MAY 2ND MEETING:




MAY 16TH MEETING;
