**SEPTEMBER 3<sup>RD</sup> MEETING:** 




During the Sept. 3, 2013, Bluffton Lions club meeting three new members were inducted into the club by PDG Barbara Plaugher. Lion Dick Ramseyer sponsored Omar Khokhar and Lion Greg Denecker sponsored both Kyle Leatherman & Mike Minning.

The guest speaker was Andy Chaffee, a 2012 graduate of Bluffton University, who gave a power point presentation about competing in his first Ironman triathlon at Lake placid, NY. He shared about the preparation for such a race as well as how much a year of experience can mean for an athlete as well as one doing something new. At Lake Placid his finishing time was 32 hours & 51 minutes. Just the cost for a bike needed for the event can cost between \$2,000 to \$15,000. The intake of salt, calories and monitoring weight are critical elements in the training and completing in an event. His most recent challenge was competing in the Little Smoky Half Ironman. From that experience he determined the need to change and improve his training techniques.

# **SEPTEMBER 17<sup>TH</sup> MEETING:**

The program at the Bluffton Lions Club meeting was provided by Dan Litchfield, Business Developer, Iberdrola Renewables LLC. The title of his power point presentation was 'Wind Energy of Northwest Ohio". Renewables is the world's largest operator of renewable energy generation facilities. His job is to manage the planning of renewable facilities, mainly wind farms in Ohio. This includes site identification, initiation of wind speed measurements, land leasing, preliminary engineering, local government relations, local community relations, and permitting. This project is in coordination with the Multiple District of Ohio to screen all 3 to 6 year old children in the state of Ohio and alert their parents of potential problems their child may have. This is the second year the Bluffton club has conducted these screenings.
