

MEDICARE OPEN ENROLLMENT

October 15 to December 7, 2018 is Medicare Open Enrollment. Checking your plan could save you money!! Plans change every year and if you are on new medications, it could make a big difference in your plan. Make an appointment with your insurance agent or check with your County Council on Aging. Allen County Council on Aging is 419-228-6135.

OHIO'S NEW DL-ID

As of July 2, 2018, Ohio has started issuing new drivers' license and identification cards. The new cards are to become compliant with Federal regulations that go into effect October 1, 2020. The new cards will be used for security at airports, military bases and other Federal facilities. The good news is: you may choose a standard card if you do not fly, go to military bases or have a passport; the cost is the same for a compliant card and a standard card; you still visit a Deputy Registrar for both cards. What has changed? All cards are now mailed to you. To renew a standard card, NO additional identity documents are needed. A Compliant Card will require documentation proving your name and date of birth, Social Security number, birth certificate or passport and two additional documents proving residential address such as utility bills. HOLMES COUNTY, OCTOBER 16, 2018

Bright and early, fifty-one seniors were waiting on the bus to arrive and to load up and head east to Holmes County. A little mix up about the time, but Henry arrived with the bus and everyone loaded and off we went at 8:15 a.m. (instead of 8 a.m.). Being so early, the bus loaded with people visiting for about an hour or so and then it got quiet (probably taking a nap). Continued east and after a stop for convenience, plus juice and homemade cookies, we then continued to SMUCKER'S at Orrville, Ohio The store & café have many products and brands (fruit spreads, coffee (Folgers), pet food, and snacks along with signature branded gifts and kitchen accessories). The company started in 1897 by Jerome Monroe Smucker with a small custom cider mill. With a surplus of local apples, he began crafting his homemade cider and apple butter. He peddled his products in stone crocks, from door to door with his horse-drawn wagon. Each crock bore a hand signed seal as his personal guarantee of quality. Today, every jar of Smucker's spread contains his signature. The stores are in 30 locations or more in North America. They are proud to have success through five generations of family leadership. Quite a few of us left the store with one or more sacks with "goodies" inside.

Continued then down the road, up and down hills, and enjoying the scenery of Amish working in the fields, shocks in the corn field, country schools with children outside playing games, beautiful flowers around the homes, and last LAUNDRY hanging on a line from the house and out to the barn on whatever type of line that held it all, and last BUGGIES. Soon we arrived at Berlin, Ohio, at the Amish Country Theater. We were greeted by one of the personal that performs in the shows handed out tickets and directed us to the room for our noon meal. It was a buffet line and very tasty! About 1:30 p.m. we then were directed to the theater for the afternoon show. It was about a two hour show which has been voted a Top 100 Event in North America by American Bus Assoc. This theater holds about 600 people, latest lighting, video&sound equipment. Ken Groves, ventriloquist, was the MC and greeted us all plus his side-kick, Comedian Lynerd, known as the country bumpkin of Amish Country. Also, a quartet known as the "Udder Harmony", (four young men) sang several songs for us. Ken then chattered with his puppets, involved people from the audience in several skits, and I don't believe anyone left without smiling. Our group was represented by Ted Cunningham who was involved in the last skit with Ken, being a "human" puppet plus three other people from the crowd. They did a great job! Ask Ted!!!

Back on the bus and on to the BIG store, Walnut Creek Cheese & Grocery store. We were given about 1 hour or so to shop and get a bite to eat (could eat on the bus). Again, a lot of us came on the bus with several bags of "goodies" – breakfast rolls, breads, cheeses, trail boloney, fried pies, and some homemade ice cream! The bus was rather quiet as we left the area because people were eating or sleeping from the busy day. Arrived at Bluffton about 8:30 p.m. and I feel that everyone had a good time and the weather was nice for a "country drive through the Amish area." Again, we want to thank Bev and Bob for offering us this trip and for Henry, the bus driver, making the trip a safe one.




