



INCOME TAX

AARP volunteers will once again be offering FREE Income Tax Assistance at the Bluffton Sr. Center. The first day of taxes will be Thursday, February 2nd and will run Tuesdays and Thursdays until April 13th. The service is FREE of charge but you must make an Appointment. Because of the new program the Volunteers are using, they are limited to seven (7) appointments a week, so call early to make sure you can get an appointment. At the time of your appointment, you must bring a photo ID, your Social Security card and proof of insurance or Medicare. Also, bring last years Tax Returns, SSA-1099 forms, all W2's and 1099, and any other forms you receive. If you are itemizing, please have all items added up as the volunteers do not have time to do this for you. Tax Assistance will NOT be cancelled for bad weather unless the volunteers can't make it to the Senior Center. Please use good judgement if the weather is bad!
