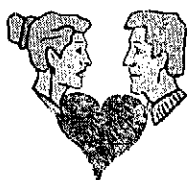

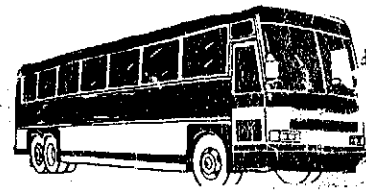

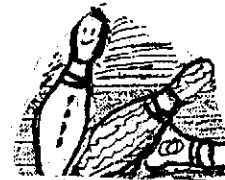

HOBBY CENTER



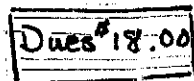

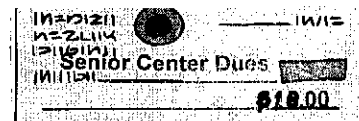
WINTER WEATHER

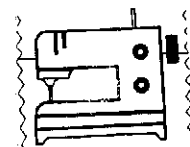
DUES

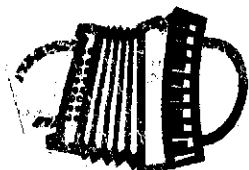

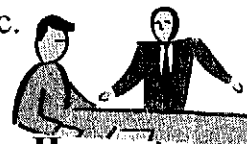
POLKA PARTY



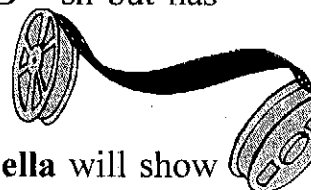
