

#### CLIFTON MILL - December 8, 2017

Friday afternoon, December 8th, 32 Senior Citizens left Bluffton for Clifton, Ohio to see the light display at Clifton Mill. Tim, our bus driver, headed south thru Ada, Kenton, Bellefontaine on route 68. About 4 p.m., we stopped at Young's Diary Farm Restaurant for supper. Had a choice of a pork chop or chicken for supper plus the trimmings. Was very delicious and after an hour or so, we boarded the bus and just a few miles down the road we were in Clifton. We got off the bus and were able to walk around the Mill site area: animated miniature village with over 100 mowing miniatures including a tiny OSU Marching band performing the 'Script Ohio' along with a football game; largest Santa Claus collection in the country; toys in Santa's workshop; a beautiful covered bridge; and last a nice gift shop with a variety of Pancake mixes grounded from the mill. At 6 p.m. the lights are switched on and a musical display of lights are flashing on and off on the covered bridge to the music from Manheim Steamrollers. It is truly unbelievable how it all goes together. You just can't figure out what to look at first or where!

A little history: lights first seen in 1988 using 100,000 lights and 1,000 Santa Clauses. Now it has grown to 3.6 million lights and more than 3,000 Santa's and takes 8 men all year to install and maintain. Owner, Anthony Satariano Sr., started the Santa collection 47 years ago and the family is still welcoming different Santa's if people want to give them away. Animated miniature village replicates Clifton including 800 ft of train tracks with a couple of little trains going on them plus more than 100 mechanical wonders it goes by. Around town, you can also see some historical buildings.

Mill is open 7 days a week, year round with the restaurant and gift shop. Light display only from Friday, after Thanksgiving thru December 31st.

Even with cold weather, I believe everyone seemed to have a good time plus enjoyed the ice cream treat on the way home back at Young's Dairy Ice Cream Shop. Thanks again to Bev for her tasty cookies and to Bob for planning a nice trip for the Christmas season. Wishing everyone a Merry Christmas




