It is everyone's favorite time TAX TIME!! AARP will offer FREE Income Tax Assistance at the Bluffton Senior Citizen's Center on Thursday mornings starting at 9 a.m. February 3rd through April 7th. This service is FREE of charge but you MUST make an appointment. Please call 419-358-8971 for an appointment. You MUST bring a Photo ID and your Social Security Card or the volunteers cannot help you with your taxes. Also, bring last years returns, current forms received by mail, SSA-1099 form if you were paid Social Security benefits, all 1099 forms showing income, all W-2s and all information concerning 2010 income. If you are itemizing, the forms will not be ready until the end of February or beginning of March, because of recent laws passed by Congress. Also, if itemizing, please have all items added up, as the volunteers do not have time to do this for you.

SMITHVILLE, OHIO and NEIGHBORING AREA

It was a cool, windy Tuesday morning (Nov. 16th) when 33 Senior Citizens boarded a Trailways bus heading east to Smithville, Ohio. After about 1 hour or so, we stopped at a rest area and there **Bob and Bev** served us fresh baked cookies, plus chocolate or banana bread along with coffee for us to enjoy. After several cookies or breads, we continued down the road heading towards Smithville.

Here we drove through town and came to **Mishler's Weaving Mill.** This is a working mill and have about 132 looms, large & small, some work by hand and some are motorized and do the weaving mechanical. About 6 weavers were working when we were touring the mill. They make rag rugs, place mats, dishcloths, curtains, bath towels, and used to make cider press cloth. But due to health regulations today, they aren't allowed to make the cider cloths anymore.

Back on the bus and back to downtown area to see the oldest church in Ohio and Smithville, Church of God. Rev. John Winebrenner was the founder of the Church of God. We then walked to the other buildings located behind the church forming their "Historical Village." We checked out the carriage barn, a log cabin, a pottery shop, a house with old furniture, a blacksmith shop and finally a tin shop.

After about 45 minutes or so, we boarded the bus and off we go to the "Barn" restaurant for lunch. Wow, what a very interesting place to eat and the food!! If you went away hungry, it was your own fault. I saw several "carry-out" containers come along with us on the bus. Surprise to us coming out to the bus, RAINING!! It continued through the rest of the day and evening plus some fog, too.

Now we were heading to Dalton to see P. Graham Dunn, "Inspiration Art, Home Décor and Gifts." They make plaques from designing, carving, and then use laser engraving on the products where writing is needed or a design. Their largest customer is Cracker Barrel restaurants and then Christian bookstores. They hire about 100 young adults being Amish and Mennonites. Their mission is to "Lift Him Up." They seek to do this with the products that remind us of who He is and what He has done by the verses and etc. with the lasers.

Continuing south to **Heini's Chesse Shop.** Rain or not, we all headed inside and the buying begun! We were allowed so much time and loaded down with many bags and we were soon back on the bus. Everyone seemed to be smiling with their purchases. Ha!

Happy and excited and looking forward to **Walnut Creek Market Place.** We were able to get a bite to eat here if we wanted to, purchase bake goods, more cheese, or gifts or just watch people. Loaded again and I mean loaded, we headed to the bus through the rain and purchases all in place headed to Bluffton.

Was rather a very quiet bus ride and one could hear the rain beating against the bus, top and sides. After an hour and half, we stopped at a rest area. Back on and settled, **Bob** asked if anyone had lot a "fishing lure?" He continued to say he found it on the floor by his seat and described it. The people in the back area started to laugh and we said the mystery was solved. **Carol Groman** claimed it and when you see her, you might ask her about her "fishing lure." Ha! 


