

### COVID – 19 Trip Policy

Masks are optional while on the motor coach but please bring a mask with you as many of the stops that we visit may require them. If someone is not willing to wear a mask, they should not sign up for a trip.

Vaccination or tests will not be required to travel with the Senior Center but is strongly encouraged. We trust that everyone traveling with us is adult enough to monitor their own health and not get on the motor coach if they are sick in any way.

In the beginning, seating on the motor coach will be restricted to 30 people. Coach companies are leaving the two rows behind the driver empty to protect the driver. As the coach companies relax their rules, we will allow more people on a trip. Please note that even if you get motion sick, you will not be allowed in the front two rows.

Exiting the coach will be from the front to the back to avoid contact with others. Please note that if you are in the back, you will be the last off.

Refund policy has not changed. If the Senior Center has to cancel a trip for any reason, full refunds will be given. If a traveler cancels a trip before final payment is due, a full refund is given. If a traveler cancels after the final payment date, a refund will be issued only if we sell their seat or we are able to get refunds from the vendors.

For travelers who are not members, the Senior Center will need their name, phone number and address in case of contract tracing.

When we are traveling with a paid tour company, their COVID-19 polices trump ours.


