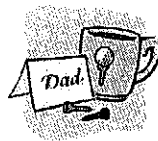

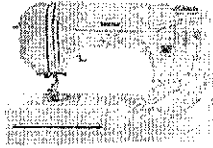

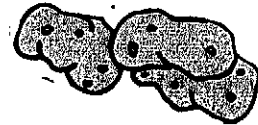

CAR SHOW



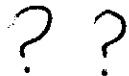

BINGO

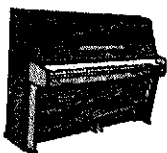

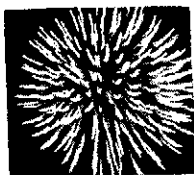
SHOWTIME AT DerDUTCHMAN, Plain City, Ohio
