

RON RETZER TRIO, Plain City October 4, 2018



Plans change every year and if you are on new medications, it could make a big difference in your plan. Make an appointment with your insurance agent or check with your County Council on Aging. Allen County Council on Aging is 419-228-6135.

OHIO'S NEW DL-ID

As of July 2, 2018, Ohio has started issuing new drivers' license and identification cards. The new cards are to become compliant with Federal regulations that go into **effect October 1**, **2020.** The new cards will be used for security at airports, military bases and other Federal facilities. The good news is: you may choose a standard card if you do not fly, go to military bases or have a passport; the cost is the same for a compliant card and a standard card; you still visit a Deputy Registrar for both cards. What has changed? All cards are now mailed to you. To renew a standard card, NO additional identity documents are needed. A Compliant Card will require documentation proving their name and date of birth, Social Security number, birth certificate or passport and two additional documents proving residential address such as utility bills. 
