Dennis Sheidler tells about his Appalachian Trail experiences

Wednesday, Oct. 25, at 2:30 p.m., Dennis Sheidler will present a power point presentation of "The Appalachian Trail." Dennis has hiked the Appalachian Trail in sections and will share photos and maps. Dennis Sheidler completed the nearly 2,200-mile Appalachian Trail last year when he summited Mt. Katahdin on July 5, 2022. This feat took 14 years of section hiking. The A.T. begins at the top of Springer Mountain in Georgia and winds through 14 states before ending at the peak on Mt. Katahdin in Maine. Mantis, as Sheidler is known on the trail, will share fun facts about the trail, the large variety of hikers and animals he encountered, the food and gear he carried, and the types of shelters he spent the night in.

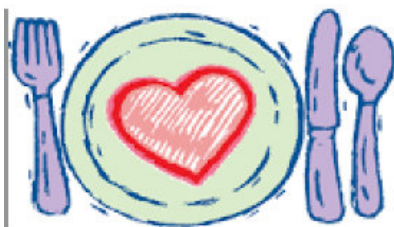

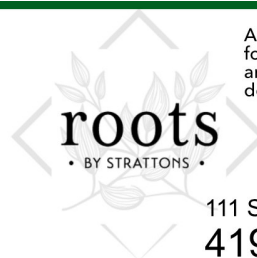

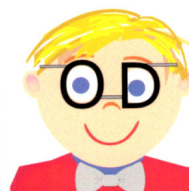

Mystery trip revealed!

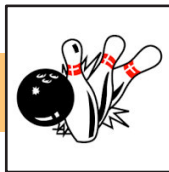

Bus Trip Policy

Sign up

The Bluffton Senior Citizens Association will officially announce new trips in the monthly newsletter. When first announced, a sign-up date will be announced. No one will be able to sign up for a trip before the sign-up date. Sign-ups will be allowed until the seats are full or it is determined that we need to close a trip.

A person is only allowed to sign up themselves and one other person for a trip.

Day Trips: Payment for day trips will be due at time of sign up. If someone is signing up two people, they must pay for two people. If signing up over the phone, payment must be made by credit card. See cancellation policy for refunds.

Overnight trips: No sign-ups will be allowed over the phone. Reservations for overnight trips must be made in person or by mail. A reservation form and deposit must be made at the time of sign-up. We will not take credit cards for overnight trips unless the tour company can take the credit card directly. Please check the tour company's cancellation policy. If they do not have one, our cancellation policy takes effect.

Cancellation Policy

The Bluffton Senior Citizens Association reserves the right to cancel a trip or tour for any reason. In the event of a cancellation by the Senior Center, money will be refunded in a timely manner. When a trip is cancelled by a traveler, the following policy will be used: If cancelled 90 days or more before the date of the trip, a full refund will be given. If cancelled between 45 and 90 days of the trip date, 50% refund will be given unless we can fill the seat. If cancelled less than 45 days before the trip date, 0% will be refunded unless we can fill the seat. If cancelled less than 5 days before the trip, no refund will be given. If the Senior Center is using a tour company to plan the trip, their cancellation policy takes precedence over ours. Please read the information from the tour company carefully.

The Bluffton Senior Citizens Association will not be held responsible for delays or disruptions caused by acts of God, public enemies, terrorist, authority of law, public works or events out of our control and doesn't guarantee to arrive at or depart from any point at a specific time.

No alcohol, drugs, smoking, vaping or weapons are allowed in the Bluffton Senior Center or on a coach during a Bluffton Senior Center tour.

Non-members of the Bluffton Senior Center are subject to an additional charge of \$20 or the amount of membership, over and above the quoted trip price.
