45 YEARS AND COUNTING UPDATE (new info, please read)

INDIANA TRIP, July 30, 2015

At 8:00 a.m., forty-eight (48) people plus bus driver, **Rick**, traveled to Indiana on a beautiful July 30th. After a rest area pit stop, we then enjoyed **Bev's** cookies & coffee. **Bev** tested our knowledge of the 50 state nicknames and gave us a 20 question multiple choice trivia quiz. **Bob** guided us to **Cook's Bison Ranch** in Wolcottville. Two wagons carried our group out to the pasture where we were greeted by 100 bison who surrounded our wagons & ate food pellets out of our hands. We returned to the barn where we dined on a lunch of slow cooked pulled bison meat, baked beans, coleslaw, corn bread, and cake.

Our next stop was Coppes Commons in Nappanee where we met our guide, Sue. The building's original use was as a kitchen cabinet factory, but it now contains 13 stores. Some of us enjoyed eating the Rocket Science Ice Cream which was made instantly using a flash frozen process as we watched. Sue guided our bus while she explained the Heritage Trail history which travels by 19 flowers quilt gardens containing more than 1,000,000 blooms & 21 hand painted quilt murals. Before leaving Nappanee, we visited 2 flower quilt gardens, and toured the John Hartman House & Heritage Welcome Center where we saw a 7" pie pan which is used annually at their apple festival.

In Wakarusa, we saw a **Wild Geese Flower Quilt** garden, and enjoyed FREE jumbo jelly beans and flavored popcorn at the **Dime Store**. We headed for Elkhart & viewed a painted elk sculpture, then went to the **Bristol Bonneyville Mill Park** dahlia test garden and painted quilt mural. In Middlebury, there were more painted quilt murals with the **Dutch Country Market** flower quilt garden containing 7700 plants.

We next traveled to Shipshewana where the **Blue Gate Restaurant** served us family style supper and pie for dessert. Afterwards we went upstairs to the theatre to enjoy the **King's Brass**, an instrumental group. When the concert ended, we followed the full moon back to the Bluffton arriving not much before midnight.


September 11, 2015, 8:00 am. Fifty One Senior Citizens departed Bluffton under sunny skies with Tim at the wheel of our Excursions Trailways Bus. We stopped South of Marion Ohio at a US 23 Rest Stop to partake of Bev's cookies and coffee. What do you mean" You don't like raisins?" We arrived at The Wilds, southeast of Zanesville about 11:30 am where we enjoyed cold cut sandwiches, salad, fruit and drink at the Wilds Overlook Café. We boarded 2 air-conditioned Safari Tour Buses. Lee, a school teacher, was our driver/ guide for the next couple hours and very knowledgeable. The Wilds is one of the largest Conservation Centers in North America, located on nearly 10,000 acres. It is home to rare and endangered species from around the World and home to hundreds of indigenous species. The mission of the Wilds is lead and inspire by connecting people and wildlife. Just a few of the animals in residency at the Wilds include; Antelope, Horned Oryx, Wild Horses, Sichuan Takin, African Painted Dogs, Cheetahs, White and Black Rhinos, Giraffe, Camels, several kinds of Deer, and Ostrich. Many man made lakes provide sanctuary for a host of birds and fish. Some of the animals remained hidden on a warm day like today. Climate controlled winter quarters are available for some animals and some weather the elements all winter long. Hospital facilities are also available. After a short visit to the gift shop, we were on our way through the hilly terrain of Belmont County. After about an hour of traveling narrow roads, State Routes, I-77 and I-70 we followed a gravel road through Muskrat Valley to the ranch which is located in the Appalachian foothills of Southeastern Ohio. The Dickinson Family own and operate this 5000 acre ranch supporting 1600 head of grass fed cattle. They raise 3 Registered breeds, Texas Longhorn, Dutch Bue Lingo and African Watusi. The cattle graze on open pasture all year long, even with a foot of snow covering the grass. The Dickinson logo is "Longhorns Head To Tail". The majority of their land is re-claimed coal mine territory, the black stuff has been removed and 6 inches of top soil replacing it. To get an up close and personal look at the cattle and the grass lands we boarded 2 school buses re-designed to cope with the rough and bumpy terrain. Two young ladies, Teu and Becky were our driver/guides for an hour or so. Everyone received a bag of "Kow Kandy" to feed the cattle. They would eat out of your hands if you choose. When the driver blew the bus horn the cattle came to the bus for a snack. The horns of the Longhorn measure 80 inches or more, tip to tip. The Dutch Bue Lingo may be mostly black or red but is unique because their white belt must completely encircle their body. The African Watusi, multi colored, have huge diameter horns at the base of their skull. Following the tour of grasslands and cattle we gathered at the barn for a dinner of Longhorn roast beef, parsley potatoes, glazed carrots etc. After dinner and a trip to the gift shop we started our 3 hour trip back to Bluffton. It's amazing to see all of these animals in their natural habitat. Bob and Bev distributed a couple brain teaser quizzes to help pass the travel time. We had a dozen prize winners.

DID YOU KNOW???

Most of the movies that the Senior Center shows in the summer are owned by the Center and can be borrowed. Did you know that the TV in the lounge area has a BVD player and a VHS player. If you don't have a player at home and want to watch a movie, just ask Tonya to set you up in the lounge. Just make sure to give yourself enough time to watch the whole movie.






