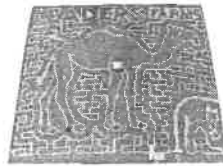

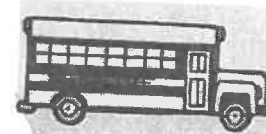

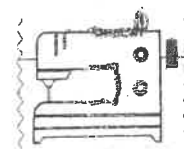
SENIOR DAY AT PRIMROSE

Wednesday, October 11th



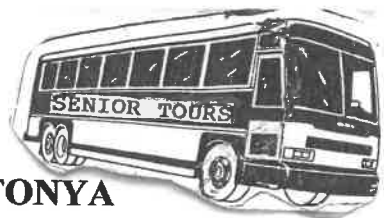

SEPTEMBER MONTHLY MEETING

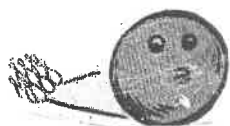

Hostess were **Mary Amstutz** and **Jo Edwards**. **Basil Meyer, MC**, asked us to remember people who were involved in the hurricane in Florida and the destruction to the twin Towers in New York, 16 years ago in our prayers. The **Mt.Cory Eastern Star No. 555** served a ham meal with the trimmings and a variety of cake for dessert. September birthdays were acknowledged. **Bob** and I shared announcements of trips left for the year and one for next year, 2018, plus the Fall Festival in Bluffton on the 23rd of September.

Gary Wetherill, guest speaker, spoke and showed us many different Indian games and toys from the east coast to the west coast of the United States. They are usually hung in the tipi, lodge or on a baby's cradle.

Basil then dismissed everyone and wished them safe traveling home and encouraged them back for the October meeting and meal.
