#### October 2020

We finally have the okay to start programming, but the list of rules and regulations are quite long. We are going to start with just a few programs in October and will expand every month as long as we all stay healthy. One way for us all to stay healthy is by getting a flu shot. We will be offering a Flu Shot Clinic on Oct. 7<sup>th</sup>. The details are in the newsletter. Also, almost every pharmacy has flu shots available. Reservations are not necessary for the Flu Shot Clinic but they are for other activities. Any significant time that is spent in the Senior Center must be documented in case the health department needs to do contact tracing. We are also limited to how many people can attend an activity. Reservations will insure that we have space for those planning on attending. If you don't see your favorite activity listed, we are sorry but we are working on it. Although some activities, like trips, will not happen until there is a vaccine for safety reasons. Welcome back everyone!

**REMEMBER** If you are sick or not feeling well or if you have been around someone who is showing symptoms of COVID 19 or if you are waiting on a COVID test or if you have been traveling out of state to a highly effected area, we ask that you refrain from coming into the Senior Center to help protect other members and the staff. THANK YOU

#### WATER BOTTLES

We recommend that if you plan to be in the Senior Center for any length of time that you bring your own water bottle as we have had to close off the drinking fountain.

#### **FLU SHOT CLINIC**

While we continue to live with the coronavirus, getting a flu shot becomes even more important. The Bluffton Senior Center will host a Flu Shot Clinic on Wed. October 7 from 10 a.m. till noon. Ohio Northern pharmacy students will be offering the clinic in the Senior Center and will have flu shots specifically for senior citizens. Please bring your Medicare or insurance card and wear a short sleeve shirt and a mask. We will need to limit the number of people in the building to fifteen at a time.

#### **BOWLING**

It may be a month late but we will start are bowling league on Thursday, October 1 at 9:30 a.m. Please arrive at Southgate Lanes a little early to get instructions and lanes. Everyone is welcome. Please follow COVID rules and stay home if you are not feeling well.

#### **COMMUNITY MEALS**

Community Meals are coming back but like everything else, it is going to be different. The meals will be drive thru/ take out only. The first meal will be on October 1 and is hosted by the English Lutheran Church. They prefer to do the meal at their church for convenience sake. The drive thru will be in their parking lot on Jackson St. and will start at 6 p.m. A donation bucket will be available with the proceeds going to the Food Pantry. The second meal will be on October 15 and served from the back of the Senior Center provided by the Bluffton Presbyterian Church. Please enter the parking lot from the Cherry St. side and come up behind the buildings. The exit will be on Elm St. Serving will begin at 6 p.m. A donation bucket will be available with the proceeds going to the Food Pantry. No drinks or silverware will be provided.

#### JAM SESSIONS

We are welcoming back the guitar players and friends to bring some live music into the Senior Center once again. The open music sessions will be Wednesday, October 7 and Wednesday, October 21 at 2 p.m. The participants are limited to ten people per state guidelines and masks are mandatory. Everyone participating will need to sign in with name, address and phone number for contact tracing. Social distancing will be maintained. Listeners will need to be on the far side of the room.

#### Addresses and Phone Numbers

When someone gets COVID 19, the local Health Department needs to be able to track down anyone who was in contact with that person to let them know. With this in mind, we need to make sure our records are up to date. If you have moved in the last year or changed your phone number, dropped your home phone or got a new cell number, please make sure we have the correct information in our records.

#### **MOVIE TIME**

We missed our summer movies but we are going to show them this fall. The first one will be "Harriet." It is the story of Harriet Tubman that came out last year. To keep our safe distance of six feet during the movie, only eight people may come to a showing. We will have showings on Fridays in October at 1:30 p.m. **RESERVATIONS ARE REQUIRED**. Please call 419-358-8971 to make your reservation. We will not be serving popcorn but you may bring your own snacks if you wish. Please use the hand sanitizer when you enter the building and please wear a mask or face covering. Please do not arrive more than 10 minutes before show time. Once the movie starts, the masks can be removed while seated.

#### **BINGO**

Bingo is back! But it will look a little different. We can only have ten players at a time so we are going to play on multiple days so everyone has a chance. Our first round will be October 12, 14 and 15 with prizes donated by Good Samaritan in Arlington. RESERVATIONS ARE REQUIRED. Please call 419-358-8971 to make your reservation. You will only be allowed to come on one of the dates listed so everyone has a chance to play. Please do not arrive more than 10 minutes before the game starts. Please wear a mask. Each seat will have four cards available. Players will choose two to play with. When the game is over, cards and markers will be left on the table for the staff to sanitize before putting away. If your friends who are not members wish to play, they will need reservations and will have to give us their address and phone number when they register for contact tracing purposes.

Our second round of Bingo will be October 26, 28 and 29 with prizes donated by Mennonite Home Communities of Ohio. All the same rules will apply, **RESERVATIONS ARE REQUIRED.** Please call 419-358-8971 to make your reservation. 




