

### Fall 2014: Drum's Collection

Music Together®'s Fall session will feature the *Drums Collection* - a collection of favorite songs, rhythm chants, tonal and rhythm patterns and instrumental play-alongs. We will be shaking egg shakers to *Biddy Biddy*, clapping, tapping, and sneaking to *Clap Your Hands*, tapping rhythm sticks to *There's a Cobbler*, and banging on pots and pans to *Playin' in the Kitchen*. Don't miss this great collection! Since children learn best through play, we'll be playing, exploring and modeling LIVE MUSIC MAKING!

### Tuition

Tuition is \$125\* and includes:

### Class Schedule
