
# **COMMUNITY MEALS**



# HOMESTEAD EXEMPTION



At this point in time, anyone 65 years of age or older in Ohio who own the property on which they live are eligible for the Homestead Exemption. The Homestead Exemption gives a discount on property taxes. You must file an exemption form which you can get at the Bluffton Senior Center. In 2014, the exemption will shift back to assist only low income seniors who make less then \$30k. Anyone who has filed for the exemption will be allowed to keep it. The change will not affect you. If you will turn 65 in 2013, you have until June 2, 2014 to file under the old rules.




