I am getting excited at the prospect of all you getting the vaccine and life getting back to some normalcy. Please know that all of our COVID 19 precautions will still be in place for the foreseeable future. Half the staff is not eligible at this time to get the vaccine and it is going to be some time until all senior citizens who can get the vaccine will be able to get it. Plus, they say we don't reach full immunity until three weeks after the second shot. All this to say, keep wearing a mask and washing your hands and keeping your distance. We have to develop herd immunity and that is still going to take a while.

REMEMBER If you are sick or not feeling well or if you have been around someone who is showing symptoms of COVID-19 or if you are waiting on a COVID test or if you have been traveling out of state to a highly effected area, we ask that you refrain from coming into the Senior Center to help protect other members and the staff. 90TH BIRTHDAYS

We missed a couple of January Birthdays in the last newsletter. Angela Schroeder and Colletta Mullenhour each turned 90 years young last month. Don't worry, we made sure they got their red rose and Life Membership last month. Congratulations Colletta and Angie and sorry we missed you.

We are now in the stage of the vaccine schedule that affects most of you. At this point, vaccines are offered in county of residence. Here is the info we have at the time of publishing. Feel free to call for updates.

Tentative dates for older Ohioans to receive vaccines:

- Jan. 19, 2021 Age 80 and older
- Jan. 25, 2021 Age 75 and older
- Feb. 1, 2021 Age 70 and older
- Feb. 8, 2021 Age 65 and older

Allen County Public Health will begin taking appointments on January 14 for the first round of Phase 1B Vaccinations – individuals age 80 and above. This age group is the first priority in the state of Ohio's Phase 1B group. Only individuals age 80 and above can make appointments at that time. (75 and up should be able to call the week of the 19 and so on.) Clinics will be held by appointment only, based on vaccine availability. To make an appointment, individuals must call 419-228-INFO (419-228-4636). This number is a direct number for scheduling – please do not call the regular health department phone number. Moving beyond this first week of clinics, Allen County Public Health will continue to offer the vaccine by appointment, based on vaccine availability. The public will be notified when appointments open up again. Please monitor local media for updated information on clinics and how to make appointments as we receive more doses, and move through Phase 1B.

Bluffton Hospital is offering vaccines to Bluffton residents in the order set by the state. Call 419-369-2323 to make an appointment.

Lima Memorial Hospital is also offering vaccines. Call 419-998-4491 to make an appointment.

Mercy Health – St. Rita's is offering vaccines to patients of their providers. Call 419-996-5000 to make an appointment.

Hancock County Health Dept has an on line sign up for the vaccine. Go to their website to sign up. If you need help with the internet, please call us or call 50 North in Findlay for help.

Putnam County Health Dept is taking phone reservations for those in the proper age group. Please call 419-538-7001 between 9 am and 2 pm.

Hardin County had its first vaccine clinic on Jan 20 and it was full. Please call 419-673-6230 to register for the next clinic. I am unclear if they are signing up people in age order only. You will need to call to find out.

Auglaize County Health Dept is taking reservations. Please call 419-738-3410.

Crime Victim Services Observes Increase in Email & Text "Phishing" Scams

Elder Victim Ministry, a program of Crime Victim Services, is seeing an increase in "Phishing Scams," where victims give out passwords, Social Security or bank account numbers to what looks like a legitimate request from a company.

Protect yourself. 1.) Use security software and keep it updated. 2.) Take advantage of "two-factor authentication" where you enter a password plus an extra passcode sent by text or a fingerprint scan. This is especially important for software that accesses your finances. 3.) Test requests. Look up the company number and call them to verify. Run it by someone you trust before taking action.

If you think that you gave away important personal information, report to law enforcement. Elder Victim Ministry has recovery steps to follow: 419-222-8666 (Lima) or 419-523-1111 (Ottawa). The FTC recommends forwarding a phishing email to reportphishing@apwg.org and a phishing text to SPAM (7726).


