
FALL FESTIVAL



Buyer Be Wise

Last November, there was an issue on the Allen County Ballot that, if approved by voters, would allow the county to select a suppler of electrical energy for residents. This was under what is known as an "aggregate" program. After a bidding process, the Commissioners selected First Energy, a highly rated supplier of electricity, as the supplier of energy to Allen County. (Other counties in Ohio also were involved in similar aggregate plans).

Under an aggregate plan, anyone falling under the programs jurisdiction must either accept the company named, or they must "opt out."

When the letters began arriving in residents mailboxes in Allen County, a great deal of confusion ensued. The BBB began getting literally hundreds of calls concerned that this might be some sort of scam. It is not a scam.

It is all legal and above board.

First Energy is an honest, reliable company and is an A+ Accredited Business with the BBB.

The plan does not affect citizens living within the city limits of Lima.

If you want to keep your current supplier, you must notify First Energy, either by sending in the form attached to the letter or calling: 1-866-636-3749.

Changes are a way of life these days and there comes a time when we all have to re-evaluate our circumstances.

There is supposed to be a savings with aggregate plans, the BBB cannot comment on that, but anyone contemplating a change should investigate all alternatives.


