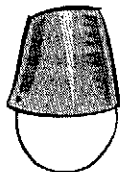
**COACH TRIPS WITH TONYA

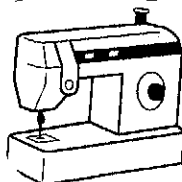
DIABETES SELF-MANAGEMENT TRAINING

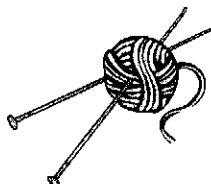

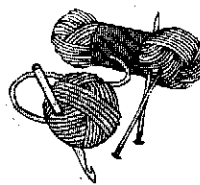

(new info, please read)

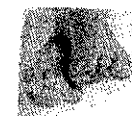

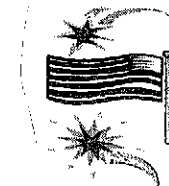
REDUCE AND RECYCLE!

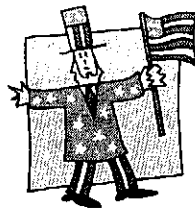

Rhubarb Meringue Pie

2-1/2 cups rhubarb, cut fine
 3 eggs, separated
 1 cup sugar
 3-1/2 tables. flour
 1/4 teas. salt
 1 small can Carnation
 1 teas. vanilla

Beat the 3 egg yolks and mix together with the rhubarb, sugar, flour, salt, vanilla, and Carnation. Pour the mixture into a prepared pie crust. Bake at 350° for 40 minutes, or until set.

Prepare your favorite meringue recipe using the 3 egg whites. Spread the meringue over the rhubarb mixture. Continue baking until the meringue is lightly browned.

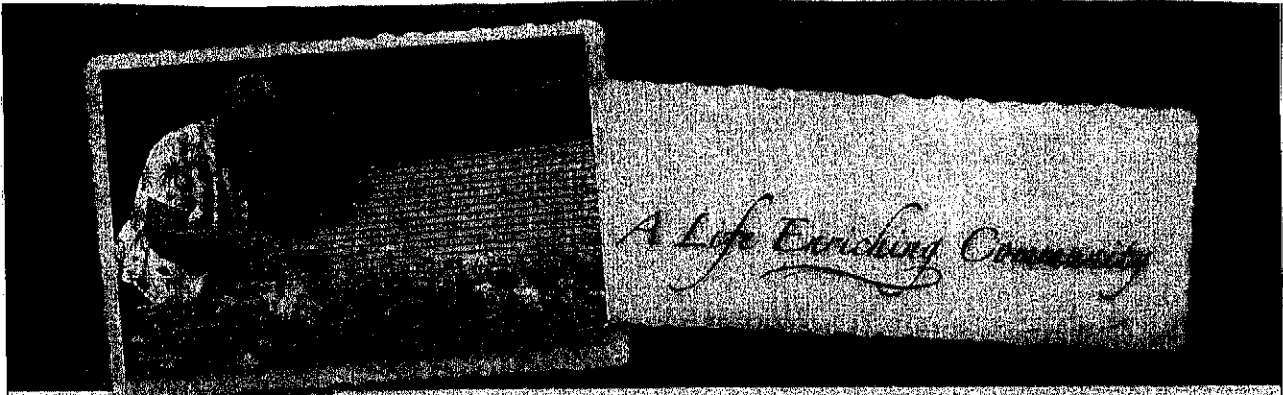

 (1) 3 oz. pkg. strawberry Jello
 1/3 cup sugar
 1 box yellow Jiffy cake mix
 1/4 cup oil
 1/2 cup warm water

Put rhubarb in greased 8 x 8 inch baking dish. Sprinkle each of the remaining ingredients (in order listed) over the top. **DO NOT MIX.** Bake at 350° for 40 minutes or until rhubarb is tender. Serve warm with ice cream.
